Background: Tuberculosis (TB) is still causing deaths in children in TB endemic countries. Majority (80%) occur in the lungs, with 5% being miliary TB. It is an Interstitial Lung Disease (ILD) with similar clinical, physiological and radiological features to other ILD and affects mainly infants and children with a high mortality rate despite available treatment. Case Presentation: A three-month old male presented during the COVID-19 pandemic with fever of 2 weeks, cough of one week, fast and difficult breathing of 6 days' duration. He received BCG vaccine 16 days after birth despite being unknowingly exposed to the TB contact from birth. He was acutely ill looking, with severe pneumonia and SPO₂ of 76% in room air. Respiratory examination showed broncho vesicular breath sounds with no added sounds. A diagnosis of Severe pneumonia? Pneumocystis Jiroveci Pneumonia (PJP) and R/O

COVID-19 was made. Subsequent reviews excluded PJP and COVID-19 and the final diagnosis was Disseminated (Miliary) TB. He was successfully treated with anti-TB medications for 12 months. Conclusion: Miliary TB presents with common and uncommon manifestations that may be confusing, and so a high index of suspicion with a careful history, focused systemic examination, imaging and bacteriological studies are strongly recommended for its early diagnosis.

The worldwide spread of the emerging respiratory disease produced by SARS-CoV-2 has become a matter of great concern to public health. The expression of the viral

receptor ACE2 in the male reproductive tract arises hypothesis about a possible targeting to testicular tissue during the infection and further implications to male fertility. However, current data of whether the virus is present or not in the seminal fluid is contrasting. Objectives: The propose of this opinion article was to describe the impact SARS-CoV-2 infection in males. We analyze SARS-CoV-2 infection and the sex differential epidemiological impact in 3 185 468 cases from 53 countries. Although men and women seem equally susceptible to infection, SARS-CoV-2 elicits worsening outcomes in males; the mean proportion of deaths in confirmed cases (male:female ratio) is 1.5 (95% CI: 1.39 – 1.62). To date, evidence shows that the stronger inflammatory response in men is a marker of disease severity and mortality, and systemic inflammation might be correlated to the altered hormone profile in male patients. More high-quality information regarding the pathophysiology of the infection and gender disparity is needed to understand the higher mortality rates in men.

Background and Objectives: Cutaneous leishmaniasis is one of the most important health-threatening diseases in Iran and other countries. Glucantime is currently used to treat this disease, but due to its side effects and high resistance, alternative therapies such as the use of nanoparticles have been considered by researchers. This study aims to investigate the anti-leishmania activity of silver nanoparticles on Leishmania major in vitro. Methods: This is an experimental study on the anti-leishmania activities of silver nanoparticles at different concentrations of 0.75-0.96 µg/ml after 24, 48 and 72 hours of exposure to 106 live Leishmania major promastigotes. The numbers of live parasites were counted by Trypan Blue on a neobar slide using optical microscope (Hemocytometer method). Glucantime and distilled water were considered as positive and negative controls, respectively. The half-maximal inhibitory concentration (IC₅₀) was calculated by SigmaPlot™ software, v?ersion 13. All reactions were done three times and their average was

considered as final result. Results: All concentrations of silver nanoparticles had anti-leishmania activity, where the concentration of 96 µg/ml had the highest effect (100%) 72 hours after exposure. The IC50 was obtained 36.67, 27.2 and 21.08 µg/ml after 24, 48 and 72 hours of exposure, respectively. Conclusion: Silver nanoparticles have an inhibitory effect on the growth of Leishmania major in different concentrations. However, further in-vivo studies are needed to determine the effectiveness of silver nanoparticles.
