The purpose of this thesis is to find the similarities and differences between *Catch-22* and *A Good Man Is Hard to Find* in the direction of literary genre in black humor. Based on works in both Chinese and English and a lot of literary criticism, the systematical research will be done in aspects of art style, language, the writing technique, major character and theme to obtain a more profound understanding of these two novels. According the research, the thesis gets conclusions as following: *Catch-22* and *A Good Man Is Hard to Find* are both tragedies, but because of the implicit and calm expression of the two authors, both the two works have the effect of comedy. The former subverts the traditional narrative mode by describing absurd plots in a spider web structure, and portrays a alienated major character - Yossarian,

who wants to escape from combat, while the latter uses the traditional linear mode to depict a hypocritical character - Grandma. The two characters are both anti-heroes. Nevertheless, *Catch-22* mostly uses repetition and symbolism to reveal the cruelty of reality and wars and show human alienation, while *A Good Man Is Hard to Find* tends to use the metaphor to express the theme of original sin, violence and redemption.

In my presentation, I will demonstrate the contrast between the pioneer of the Southern Grotesque, Flannery O'Connor, and her famous story "A Good Man is Hard to Find" with Taylor's use of the gothic in his YA novel. O'Connor adapted her version of the gothic from her predecessors such as Shelley and Poe. But she veers away from the creation of a fantastical monster tradition of the Romantics to drive the focus of the "monstrous" to the very human but harmful behaviors of her characters. Similarly, Taylor's narrative does away with the over-the-top fantasy of the Romantic tradition and instead chooses to set the narrative in a realistic space with relevant characters. The difference between O'Connor and Taylor is that in O'Connor's Southern Gothic the setting is the pinnacle of her story while Taylor's *Indigeneity* shines through with his humor, traditional storytelling, and orality in his narrative. Differences aside, it is clear that the motive of each text is a call for social reform in O'Connor's criticism of the social structure of the American South and in Taylor's criticism of colonization.

Reading interest can be seen from the level of wearability of the collection. For this reason, it is necessary to research how frequency the library collections use. The purpose of this study is to find out the student's reading interest in novel books related to the use of novel collections at the Library Unit of IPDN NTB Campus, from July 2019 to December 2020. In this study, the researcher used a descriptive method, namely by describing accurate data regarding the facts, the nature of the relationship between the phenomena under study. The results of this study indicate that the number of novel collections are 61 titles with 326 copies. The number of usability of the novel collections in the IPDN Library of the NTB Campus from July to December 2019 reached 384 books (117.79%). While the usability of the novel collection from January to December 2020 are 97 books (29.75%). There was a

decrease in the usability of novel books reaching 287 books (88.04%). Minister of Home Affairs Regulation number 21 of 2020 concerning Large-Scale Social Restrictions (PSBB) triggered a drastic decrease in the use of novel book collections at the IPDN Library, NTB Campus.

The purpose of this study is to guide the convert community (muallaf) to be able to read the Qur'an properly and correctly, equipping them with the ability to practice one of

the teachings of Islam, namely to read the holy verses of the Qur'an in order to increase the spirit of converts in practicing Islamic teachings. The object of this research is the Muslim convert community (muallaf) in Senyabang Village, Sanggau District and the Muslim Community in Menjalin Village, Menjalin District, Landak Regency. This qualitative research model targets the social community as an active part of the research process, in order to increase the effectiveness of the data collection and analysis process to produce a recommendation that is truly beneficial for the improvement of the quality of their social life. The community-based research approach is more suitable if it uses an action research model, as applied research that requires dynamic and clinical trials. The results of the study were in the form of application a method of learning the Qur'an in an easier time with the Quantum Hijaiyah method. The training and development participants showed an increase in the mastery of reading hijaiyah letters and verses of the Qur'an during 19 hours of effective learning starting from pre-test, training and post-test activities. Increasing the reading ability of participants is proven by the results of tests and testimonials or acknowledgment from each participant who acknowledges the changes and improvement in the quality of reading the verses of the Qur'an.

The library is a building and room that is specifically provided for storing and collecting notes, books and documents as well as a space that is used for reading and reading activities for the community. Until now, libraries in Indonesia are increasingly advanced and even have a very large number. One of them is the regional library owned by the West Sumbawa Regency Government, West Nusa Tenggara. The lack of public interest in visiting and reading books is caused by several obstacles. In order to attract public interest in reading at the KSB Library, the library carries out several social marketing communication activities. This study uses a qualitative approach with data collection methods interview, observation, and documentation methods. The results obtained from this study are social marketing communication strategies that are implemented in the KSB Library, including utilizing social media, using print and electronic mass media, carrying out innovative activities, and mobile library services. In the implementation of social marketing communications, there are obstacles faced, namely the availability of human

resources in the field of library science, the limitation of the number of target visitors due to the Covid 19 pandemic and the limited range of mobility. Prestasi akademik hampir selalu dikaitkan dengan tingkat kecerdasan yang dimiliki siswa. Kali ini dicoba melalui pendekatan yang berbeda, yakni prestasi akademik dikaitkan dengan metode baca yang digunakan. Tujuannya yakni untuk mengetahui perilaku membaca dikalangan siswa kaitannya dengan prestasi akademik yang mereka capai. Metode penelitian menggunakan eksperimen. Kelompok eksperimen yang terdiri dari 4 (empat) unit dan kelompok kontrol terdiri dari 4 (empat) unit. bahwa kemampuan baca siswa SMA yakni pada teks 1000 kata, dan kurang berkembang pada teks 2000 kata. Faktor jenis kelamin siswa IPA memiliki hubungan non-signifikan dengan prestasi akademik. Sementara faktor jenis kelamin siswa IPS memiliki hubungan signifikan dengan prestasi akademik. Faktor boarding school siswa IPA dan IPS memiliki hubungan non-signifikan dengan prestasi akademik. Metode baca good reading belum mampu mendongkrak prestasi akademik. Sementara metode baca reading habit mampu mendongkrak prestasi akademik. Dapat disimpulkan bahwa good reading sebagai metode baca memiliki koefisien keeratan tingkat moderat sampai dengan tingkat sangat kuat jika dikaitkan dengan prestasi akademik, artinya siswa cukup adaptif terhadap good reading sebagai metode baca.

ANCIENT EGYPTIAN BOOK OF THE AFTERLIFE

What is the Egyptian book of the dead called? A document that changed the world: “The Book of Going Forth by Day”, known more commonly today as “The Book of the Dead”, a set of spells and images from Egyptian funerary equipment, by about 1600 BCE.
