Over the next decade, the band achieved influence, approval from music critics, and significant commercial success with the albums *Animal Magnetism* (1980), *Blackout* (1982), *Love at First Sting* (1984), the live recording *World Wide Live* (1985), *Savage Amusement* (1988), their best-selling compilation *Best of Rockers 'n' ...*

What happened to the lead singer of Scorpions? After a 1981 world tour and during the recording of the *Blackout* album, Meine lost his voice to the extent that he could not even speak properly. He was advised by his doctor to consider another profession. However, Scorpions stuck together and, after therapy and two vocal cord surgeries, Meine's voice recovered.

How many albums does Scorpions have? The following is a comprehensive discography of Scorpions, a German rock band. The band have released 19 studio

A psychological disorder is an ongoing dysfunctional pattern of thought, emotion, and behaviour that causes significant distress and that is considered deviant in that person's culture or society. According to the bio-psycho-social model, psychological disorders have biological, psychological, and social causes.

The DSM-5 classifies psychotic disorders that involve psychosis, or a break in reality, like in schizophrenia, delusional disorder, brief psychotic disorder, schizophreniform disorder, schizoaffective disorder, substance/medication-induced psychotic disorder, and psychotic disorder due to another medical condition.

What are the four features that might indicate a psychological disorder? In general, the four common features of an abnormality are: deviance, distress, dysfunction, and danger. Deviance. Any deviation from accepted norms in a society (or a culture) is considered abnormal. For instance, in western countries, talking to ones self is enough to raise a red flag.

According to this definition, the presence of a psychological disorder is signaled by significant disturbances in thoughts, feelings, and behaviors; these disturbances must reflect some kind of dysfunction (biological, psychological, or developmental), must cause significant impairment in one's life, and must not ...

While there is debate surrounding the terms used — and unwarranted stigma associated with those terms — abnormal psychology deals primarily with major mental and behavioral disorders, or conditions and illnesses that detract from an individual's mental, emotional and behavioral health.

What is abnormal psychology called now? Psychopathology is a similar term to abnormal psychology, but may have more of an implication of an underlying pathology (disease process), which assumes the medical model of mental disturbance and as such, is a term more commonly used in the medical specialty known as psychiatry.
