Use a spare cable to replace the currently used one and see if the situation will improve. Use another input terminal of the TV. Connect your device to other input terminals of your TV.

To find this option, go to your TV's settings menu and look for the display or picture options. Once you've found the option, select it and choose the option that best fits your screen.

What are the symptoms of bad LCD? Common signs of LCD display damage may include cracks or breaks on the screen, dead or stuck pixels that show one color or no color at all, lines, spots, or blobs on the screen, flickering or fading of the backlight, distorted colors or contrast, blurry or ghost images, and no image or signal.

What is the average lifespan of a LCD TV? Things You Should Know. LED TVs have the longest life span (11-16 years) with low brightness settings applied. Plasma TVs last only 5-7 years, while LCD screens last 5-10 years. Keep your new TV longer using its Energy Saving mode and a surge protector.

How do you troubleshoot an LCD screen? Make sure your source is on and firmly connected. If the LED on the monitor is amber, this means the monitor is receiving power but not receiving a video signal from your source. Ensure the monitor is set to the correct input and try swapping out sources to determine if that is the root of the problem.

#### How to reboot an LCD?

Can you fix a LCD TV screen without replacing it? Unfortunately, not all TV screens can be repaired. The type of television you have, for example, LED or LCD TV, as well as the extent of the damage will determine whether or not a repair is an option. In some cases, it may be possible to have the screen repaired by a professional.

**Do TVs have a reset button?** If that happens, you can force your TV to reset by following these steps: Using a straightened paper clip or ball-point pen, press and hold the recessed RESET button on your TV connector panel. Continue to hold the RESET button for approximately 15 seconds.

**How do I test my LCD?** Ensure the monitor is plugged into a known working AC outlet. Turn on the monitor. The Power indicator light will turn on and green, and a CABLE DISCONNECTED box will appear with four color bars (red, green, blue and white). This indicates the LCD is functioning properly.

Can a damaged LCD TV screen be repaired? A cracked TV screen can be repaired or replaced by trained professionals. Due to a cracked screen being the most 'intense' type of damage, this would need to be assessed by a technician and conducted accordingly. TV screens can be easily damaged and, due to their design, are somewhat fragile and delicate.
