What is the format of the California written driving test? There are 46 questions on the permit test, all of which are either multiple-choice or true/false. You will be presented with a question, example, or scenario, and then asked to respond with the correct answer. You need at least 38 correct answers to pass, equating to a passing mark of 83%.

Can the California DMV written test be taken online? The at-home online knowledge test is available online weekdays Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., except on State holidays. The test is supervised remotely, so it requires you to use a webcam and cannot be done on a smartphone or tablet.

Is it hard to pass the California written driving test? Most people pass the written test with no problem if they have studied, so you will have nothing to stress about as long as you have prepared beforehand. Take your time, read the questions carefully, and don't be in a hurry to finish.

How many mistakes are allowed in a CA DMV written test? The written test for provisional license applicants has 46 questions. You're allowed a maximum of 8 errors. The written test for adult original license applicants has 36 questions; 5 errors are allowed. The written test for license renewal applicants has 18 questions, 3 errors are allowed.

What are automatic fails on a driving test in California? You make a sudden stop on a freeway-merge lane. You don't check your blind spot when changing lanes. You drive 10 mph over or under the speed limit. You drive in the wrong lane or in the bike lane.

Can I get my license without taking the written test in California? Before you can get a California driver's license (DL) of any kind, you will need to pass knowledge and drive tests to show that you understand the rules of the road and are comfortable driving the vehicle that the license will allow you to drive.

How many questions are on the California DMV written test for seniors? Inperson Knowledge Test (Written Test) If you are renewing, the test will be 25 questions offered in English and many other languages. If you take the written test in a foreign language, you must also take a traffic signs test.

What happens if you fail your written test three times in California? If you fail the test all 3 times, you must start over by filling out a new application and paying the appropriate fees. Remember, questions for this test are taken from the California Driver Handbook.

What is the passing score for the DMV written test in CA? In order to get your learner's permit, you'll need to take the California DMV written test, which will have 46 questions and you'll be required to answer 38 correctly to pass.

Does it cost money to retake DMV written test California? The test consists of 46 questions — 38 of which you must answer correctly to pass. While you can always retake the test if you fail the first time, you have only three chances to pass within 12

months of paying the \$39 fee before having to start the application process all over again.

How many languages are offered in California DMV? The online test is offered in 35 languages to customers who have an internet-enabled computer or laptop with a webcam. It is available between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. Monday through Friday, excluding state holidays. The test cannot be taken on a tablet or mobile device.
