Guidebooks for guided reading methods through tiered books have not been found in learning reading skills. Still, based on several previous studies, the impact of using guided reading methods and tiered book media is very effective in reading skills. Therefore, this study aims to develop a guidebook product for guided reading methods through tiered books to improve the reading skills of grade 1 elementary school students. This study used a Research and Development (R&D) approach using the 4D development model, focusing on the 3 stages of 4D development namely define, design, and develop. The research subjects comprised 1 grade 1 teacher and 32 grade-1 students at SD Negeri Sarirejo 1, Demak. The data collection technique used a questionnaire which was then analyzed and described to provide an overview of the feasibility and effectiveness of the guidebook. The product feasibility test was analyzed using percentages and the product effectiveness test was analyzed using the Wilcoxon Signed Rank Test, t-test, and N-Gain test. The results of the study explained that the guidebook for guided reading methods through leveled books was said to be feasible with a value of 92.4% from media experts, 92% from material experts, and 89.7% from practitioners. The results also provide an effectiveness value through a t-test with the value of the H_a t-test analysis accepted and the N-Gain obtained is 0.63. Thus, it can be explained simply that the guidebook for guided reading methods using tiered books is feasible and effective to be used by teachers to support Indonesian language learning, especially in reading skills.

The convergence of military strategy and mathematics in war games, from medieval to modern times.

For centuries, both mathematical and military thinkers have used game-like scenarios to test their visions of mastering a complex world through symbolic operations. By the end of World War I, mathematical and military discourse in Germany simultaneously discovered the game as a productive concept. Mathematics and military strategy converged in World War II when mathematicians designed fields of operation. In this book, Philipp von Hilgers examines the theory and practice of war games through history, from the medieval game boards, captured on parchment, to the paper map exercises of the Third Reich. Von Hilgers considers how and why war games came to exist: why mathematical and military thinkers created simulations of one of the most unpredictable human activities on earth.

Von Hilgers begins with the medieval rythmomachia, or Battle of Numbers, then reconstructs the ideas about war and games in the baroque period. He investigates the role of George Leopold von Reischwitz's tactical war game in nineteenth-century Prussia and describes the artifact itself: a game board–topped table with drawers for game implements. He explains Clausewitz's emphasis on the “fog of war” and the accompanying element of incalculability, examines the contributions of such thinkers as Clausewitz, Leibniz, Wittgenstein, and von Neumann, and investigates the war games of the German military between the two World Wars. Baudrillard declared this to be the age of simulacra; war games stand contrariwise as simulations that have not been subsumed in absolute virtuality.

The purpose of this paper is to encourage re-reading and re-evaluation of a series of educational polemics published in the UK in the 1960s and 1970s, the Black Papers. These works proposed, for the most part, avowedly conservative views on education: condemning so-called “progressive” teaching methods and the re-organisation of secondary schools in the UK (especially England) into non-selective comprehensives. It is argued, however, that much said and written about the Black Papers since has concentrated only on selected “high profile” contributors, to the neglect of other contributors, often anonymous, whose comments were sometimes more measured/thoughtful.

The work proceeds first by re-visiting the facts surrounding the writing of the Black Papers and their critical reception. It then analyses the nature of the contributors and describes selected essays not usually referred to when the Black Papers are discussed by historians and others.

The work finds that the Black Papers are often infuriatingly and unhelpful polemical in nature but that much written about them since has concentrated only on selected contributors, ignoring others who were more measured.

What is the spark plug problem with the 5.4 Triton engine? The problem stems from the threads themselves. The spark plugs Ford used on these engines didn't have enough threads, and the threads they did have were soft and weak, meaning that the pressure from the combustion was able to blow the plugs out of the engine.

Why is the Ford 5.0 so good? Remember, the F-150 truck's 5.0-liter produces more torque than its counterpart. The short duration of its cams on the intake side (the amount of time the valves remain open) helps promote increased cylinder pressure, which contributes greatly to the engine's torque output.

How much HP can a 5.0 L V8 handle? The original 5.0L, debuting in the 80's, packed 225 horsepower at its peak. Aftermarket builds showed that the stock iron block was good for about 500 horsepower before separating into smaller pieces.

How much HP does a 5.0 L V8 F-150 make?

Is the Ford 5.0 302 a good engine? The 302 is a great engine if you are looking for one that will be able to last a long time and give you a good amount of power. The high production numbers make them easy to work on and there are a lot of spare parts out there if you need them as well.

Is the 5.0 in the F-150 the same as the Mustang? In terms of performance, the Mustang's Coyote has more horsepower and the F-150's Coyote has more low-end torque. The F-150 Coyote engine hits its peak torque at around 3,850 RPM

compared to 4,250 RPM for the Mustang.

Does Ford still use the 5.0 in F-150? The 5.0L Ti-VCT V8 engine comes standard on the 2021 and 2022 Ford F-150 King Ranch® and Platinum trim levels.

Where are Ford 5.0 engines made? Essex Engine Plant is a Ford factory located in Windsor, Ontario, Canada. It currently produces Ford's 5.0L V8 engine. The plant was built in 1981 to produce Ford's Essex V6 engine.

How reliable is the 5.0 V8? In terms of durability, the Ford 5.0 engine is built to last. It features high-strength connecting rods and a deep-sump oil pan to increase strength and reduce wear, and it also has a structural oil pan to reduce noise and vibration.

Which Ford F-150 engine is best? Clearly, the EcoBoost is the best option if you want more horsepower, torque, towing capacity, or better fuel economy. However, the V8 engine is rated to haul more cargo and comes available on more trim levels.

How many miles can a 5.0 V8 F-150 last? But, how long does a Ford F-150 last? A Ford F-150 is expected to last around 200,000 miles when properly cared for. Since the average driver clocks in about 12,000 miles per year, this comes out to roughly 17 years.
